The City of Tallahassee's Department of Community Housing and Human Services (CHHS) is holding a public meeting on March 9, 2017. Citizens and organizations are invited to attend this meeting to help identify housing and community development needs in the community that may be addressed with federal grant funds provided to CHHS from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The meeting will address the following areas:

CAPER: To report on the housing activities of the CHHS for the past fiscal year (2015-2016) using federal and state funds as reported in the Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) and the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program as reported in the Annual Plan to Florida Housing Finance Corporation.

Annual Action Plan: To gather information that may assist in the development of the Annual Action Plan for fiscal year 2017-2018 as required by HUD.

Input with respect to completed activities from the CAPER or additional input regarding local housing and community development needs will be accepted at this meeting and throughout the development process.
