FACTS TO SUPPORT ABOVE CHARGE(S):

On 05-13-2018 at 8:33pm I was dispatched to 1602 Stuckey Ave (Homefront Apts) in reference to a firearm being fired in the area.

Call notes advised the following:

COMPLAINANT JUST HEARD 3 GUNSHOTS (TIME DELAY 10 SECONDS). COMPLAINANT SAID SHE HEARD LOUD YELLING OUTSIDE BEFORE THE SHOTS. AN ADDITIONAL CALLER ADVISED THERE IS A MALE WALKING ON MCCASKILL AVE SHOOTING A GUN. THE SUSPECT IS JERALD. HE IS A BLACK MALE WEARING A BROWN SHIRT AND BROWN PANTS. THE SUSPECT WAS LAST SEEN WALKING WEST BOUND ON MCCASKILL AVE.

I arrived on scene with Ofc. Z. Jones #508 and immediately began to bolo the area for a suspect matching the provided description. We walked into 1616 McCaskill Ave (Kona Apts) and asked subjects in the area what happened. Multiple people advised they heard several gunshots in the area but were mostly uncooperative in providing further information.

We continued to bolo the area on foot and moments later I observed Jerald Williams (arrestee) walking east bound on Stuckey Ave just north of the Kona Apts. He was walking very fast and appeared excited and flustered.

He was wearing a dark brown t-shirt and light brown shorts. His hair was black and in the style of an afro, he also had a black goatee. He was approximately 5'10" 190lbs with a dark skin complexion. Both of his forearms had scratch marks which appeared to be fresh with red with wet blood.

Jones ordered Jerald to stop and lay face down on the ground. He complied and I placed him in double locked handcuffs. I conducted a pat down to ensure he did not have a firearm on his person, then placed him into the rear of Ofc. B. Clayton's #534 patrol vehicle. While I was walking Jerald to the patrol vehicle he made several excited utterances. He advised He was in a fight with another party when a firearm was brought into play. He then advised "I wanted to let them know I ain't afraid of no gun". He then went on to state "I ain't do nothing, y'all ain't got no gun". At this point no officer on scene had made any statement what so ever concerning a gun.

I read Jerald his Miranda Warning via department issued Miranda Card. [REDACTED]

At this time, I made contact with one of the original complainants Danisha Beal (witness). She advised she was on playground near the center of the Kona Apts when a black male began arguing with another male who was

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in a wheel chair and had one leg. They were both standing on the sidewalk north of Kona Apts. The two were yelling and screaming during the entire argument the black male had a weapon brandished. During the argument the male lifted the firearm into the air and fired off 3 rounds. After the shots were fired the male with the gun walked west bound on Stuckey Ave, then punched a mailbox near the sidewalk before leaving the area.

She described the male as a dark skin black male with black hair which had “nappy puffs”. He was wearing a beige shirt and black shorts. She advised he lives in the area and she has seen him multiple times. She described the firearm as a large black firearm, similar to my department issued duty weapon (Glock 22 semiautomatic firearm).

Danisha completed a sworn written statement.

Danisha then agreed to participate in a show up with Jerald. Jerald was placed in the roadway on Stuckey Ave just north of the Kona Apts. He was illuminated with multiple vehicle spots lights to conceal Danisha’s identity and provide a clear image of his person. She quickly advised “that’s him”. I asked her to express how sure she was that Jerald was the shooter by using a percentage. She responded “100%”.

More resources responded and an area canvass was completed. Units also searched the nearby apartments to ensure no stray bullets hit the buildings. Officers were ultimately able to locate 2 spent shell casings and 1 bullet in front of the entrance to 1602 Stuckey Ave (Home Front Apts). The shell casings and bullet were labeled “9mm FCR LUGER” and the casing was silver. These items were impounded as evidence. The rounds were photographed by Ofc. C. Collins #544 with camera #3134 before they were recovered.

Collins then spoke with Mark Cooper (witness). Cooper advised a black male named Jerald who he knows through mutual friends was walking in the area. Jerald then began to argue with a male in a wheel chair. He advised Jerald got beat up a few days prior and now carries a firearm for protection. During the altercation Jerald stated he was tired of people fucking with him, then lifted a handgun into the air and fired 3 shots. After the shots were fired Jerald simply walked away. Mark completed a sworn written statement.

Sgt R. Abney #234 responded to the scene and Inv. Megna was advised of the incident.

Jerald was discovered to be a convicted felon and had received 2 convictions for felony battery in 2016 from charges filed by the Leon County Sheriff’s Office.

He was subsequently charged with the following:

POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A CONVICTED FELON (F.S.S. 790.23(1)(a))  
DISCHARGING A FIREARM IN PUBLIC (F.S.S. 790.15(1))  
IMPROPER EXIHBITION OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON (F.S.S. 790.10)

Jerald did not qualify for a notice to appear or adult pretrial diversion program as the charge for possession of a firearm by a convicted felon (F.S.S. 790.23(1)(a)) is a felony.

A search warrant was obtained for Jerald’s primary residence of 1698 Stuckey Ave apt 5 (Harmony Crossing Apts), and signed by the Honorable Judge Dodson. A search of the premises was conducted and a firearm was located within on the floor in a bedroom. The firearm was a Hi Point 9mm pistol (Serial #P1911544). A FCIC/NCIC search of the weapon revealed that it was reported stolen ref TPD Case #18-10441.

As a result of this Jerald as also charged with GRAND THEFT OF A FIREARM (F.S.S. 812.014(2)(c)(5))  
The firearm was seized and impounded as evidence. It was removed from FCIC/NCIC as stolen.
