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Microchip Identification Form

Reuniting lost or stolen pets with their owners is a top priority at the Animal Service Center. In addition to standard identification tags worn on a collar, we strongly recommend that your pet be permanently identified with a microchip. A microchip is the size of a grain of rice, and is implanted between the animal's shoulder blades. The microchip is encoded with a one-of-a-kind number that will be kept on file at the Animal Service Center, and, if you chose, can also be registered in a national database. Once a lost pet arrives at an animal shelter or veterinary clinic, a handheld scanner is used to identify the unique number on the implanted microchip and the owner is identified and contacted. The implantation procedure takes only a few seconds and is relatively painless to the animal. Pets of all species, breeds and ages can be microchipped. A microchip is **not** a tracking device or a GPS transmitting device. Animals with microchips cannot be tracked or monitored from a remote location.
