

2.3 Employment by Industry

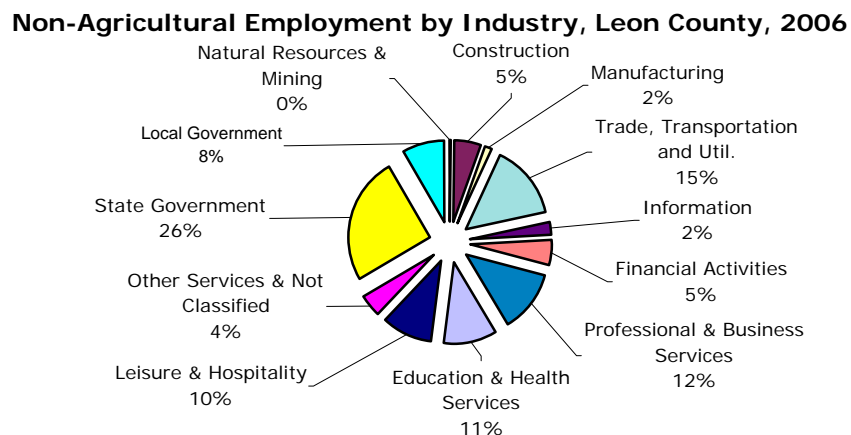
Between 2001 and 2006, non-agricultural employment in Leon County grew 0.5% per year on average. The construction industry grew 5.6% per year and added 2,146 jobs during the period while Leisure & Hospitality grew 4.5% per year and added 3,185 jobs. State Government, Information and Manufacturing suffered the greatest job losses in Leon County between 2001 and 2006
