

2.7 Average Annual Employment/Wages

The average annual wage in Leon County in 2006 was \$36,030, 6.4% below the state average wage of \$38,498. The annual average state government wage was 3.3% higher in Leon County compared to the state average while the local government wage was 8.1% lower than the state average.
