

Old City Cemetery Burials

This report shows all burials in the Old City Cemetery, Tallahassee, Florida, according to the best information currently available from two sources:

- (1) Municipal cemetery-plot sales. These records are not yet fully automated, and may never be (thanks to the loss of many of them in a fire in the mid-20th century).
- (2) An independent project undertaken by one Claude Kennison of Tallahassee. Mr. Kennison researched local histories, city records, markers in the cemetery, advertisements and news reports, newspaper obituaries and death notices, for information about anyone buried in Old City Cemetery. His research, while extremely thorough, was marred by a slight racial focus (the title of his report is "White Burials in Old City Cemetery"). Nevertheless, it remains an important contribution to the historical understanding of Tallahassee's first century. We are grateful to Beth Lacivita of the Tallahassee Trust for Historic Preservation for preserving Mr. Kennison's work, and to Paul Donovan of the Florida Department of State for making it available to us in electronic form.
