On-going Studio Art Classes

These on-going classes are offered on a weekly basis in the Art Studios at the Tallahassee Senior Center. The instructors work with individuals with varied skill levels while students assist and critique one another in an exciting, collaborative environment. To participate, come and visit, chat with the instructor, find out what art supplies you need to bring for class and jump in. No preregistration required for these On-going Studio Classes, just pay the days you come. Fee per class: \$10 (age 50 and older), \$12 (age 18 - 49). Ask about art cards – pay for 7 classes and get one free. Check with instructors about anticipated no-class days. The Senior Center closes for major holidays, maintenance week and no art classes during some specials events.

Art Workshops listed on the other side of this flyer do require pre-registration.

Drawing Like Durer & Friends – Mark Fletcher, Mondays, 12:30 – 3 pm, TSC Clay Studio.

Drawing with pencil, pen & ink, inspired by study of master artists. Beginning students and continuing artists.
