This agreement is made between the City of Tallahassee and the applicant customer for purposes stated herein and agreed to as follows:

1. **The Customer agrees:**
 - a. That the building is Owned
 Rented or leased: Customer will secure the owner's permission to install rebated appliances.
 - b. To replace existing non-natural gas water heater.
 - c. To use a licensed Master Gas Fitter to perform the installation in accordance with this agreement.
 - d. To submit (along with this agreement) a copy of the contractor's bid indicating the work to be performed. The bid must include your name and address, the cost and nature of the installation(s), and the manufacturer's name and model number of the natural gas water heater to be installed.
 - e. To allow the City's Building Inspector to enter the property/dwelling in order to inspect the installed gas appliances for compliance with established City, County and State codes, standards and laws.
 - f. To be solely responsible to the contractor for any costs exceeding the amount(s) of the City's rebate(s). (The customer is responsible for all costs if the City's rebate check is provided directly to the customer.)
 - g. To release and hold the City harmless from claims of any kind or nature arising either wholly or in part from the contractor's negligence, intentional acts or omission in performance of the installation; or from any acts/omissions by City Employees.
 - h. That the City is not a party to the installation contract between the customer and contractor.
 - i. That the City does not recommend, endorse or certify contractors, or warrant or otherwise guarantee their work.
 - j. That ***the City's rebate check will be mailed directly to the installing contractor unless the customer requests otherwise (below).***
 Send water heater rebate check to customer (requires that customer's paid invoice be provided to the City).
2. **The City agrees:**
 - a. To pay applicable rebates, upon receipt of this agreement and 1) required contractor proposals (and paid invoices if required), and 2) the City's Gas Inspection Report listing installed/inspected gas appliances.
 - b. The City of Tallahassee shall have the right to terminate this agreement if the customer fails to complete the installation within thirty (30) days of the date written below. Failure to promptly terminate this agreement upon the expiration of said time period shall not waive the City's right to terminate at a later date.
