## PROGRAM OF EVENTS

We are honored to host The 2023 Open at Tallahassee (MPO/FPO/MP40) presented by Visit Tallahassee, a sanctioned A-Tier event designed specifically for your disc golf enjoyment. This year, the added cash for Pro Divisions has increased to \$20,000. An 18-hole layout (Par 65/63/62, 7,825ft/8,910ft/8,895ft) has been designed and each division will play a single round each day using tee times. Initial Round 1 tee times will be posted on the PDGA event site at least one full day before the event.

Players: Please remember to double check your tee time prior to each competition day. The City of Tallahassee, Tallahassee Disc Golf Association, and Visit Tallahassee would like to thank the competitors for their participation and the spectators for being here to support the players. 

## **GENERAL RULES**

- Two Meter Rule is not in effect. All wooden fences are OB. Your disc must be touching on the inbound side of the wooden structure of the fence to be declared safe.
- The yellow cable ropes located on Holes 4, 8, 10, 13, and 18 are not OB indicators, but you may take a one-meter relief from the ropes if desired.
- Spectator ropes do not mark OB. Solid white painted lines and string lines do mark OB.
   On or beyond these lines is OB.
- White flags are used solely to indicate where OB lines are located.
- Should there be any water present, such water is considered casual unless noted otherwise.
- Disc coming to rest on any bridge is considered OB.

## HOLE-BY-HOLE RULES

#### Hole 1

Fence on LEFT is OB. Paved trail (and beyond marked by white painted line) behind basket is OB. OB located along entire right side of hole. Mando located on RIGHT tree. If Mando is missed, throw from Drop Zone with penalty.

#### Hole 2

Fences and paved road on RIGHT and beyond are OB.

#### Hole 3

Trail users have right-of-way. Paved trail (marked by white painted lines) and pavilion are OB.

#### Hole 4 MPO Tee

If drive does not come to rest safely inbounds, proceed to Drop Zone (FPO Tee) with penalty. Sidewalks are not OB. Parking lot fence, bridge, paved road, and beyond are OB.

#### Hole 4 FPO/MP40 Tee

Sidewalk on LEFT (and beyond) is OB. Parking lot fence, water, bridge, paved road, and beyond are OB.

#### Hole 5

No OB anywhere. Mando located on RIGHT tree. If Mando is missed, throw from DROP Zone (Short Tee) with penalty. (Note: white line at near ditch is the OB line for Hole 6 only).

#### Hole 6

Road and beyond is OB. The big, marked ditch before and closest to basket and on bridge are OB. (MPO Tee: Official tee box marked by black lines).

## HOLE-BY-HOLE RULES cont.

#### Hole 7

The first road (at FPO Tee) is not OB. All other roads are OB. Marked ditch and on bridge are OB. OB LEFT & RIGHT before marked ditch. Sidewalk behind basket and beyond is OB.

#### Hole 8

Surrounded by water in the near creek is OB. Bridge is OB. Ditch in front of putting green (Relief Area) is not OB. If disc lands in the Relief Area, player has option to throw from current lie or throw from designated Drop Zone (without penalty).

#### Hole 9

Tee is considered an island and is inbounds. If drive does not cross land in-bounds (i.e. beyond the near road), player must re-tee with penalty. Paved roads are OB. Otherwise, normal OB rules apply. Mandos are located on near LEFT tree and on far RIGHT tree. If the 1st Mando (on LEFT) is missed, must re-tee with penalty. If the 2nd Mando (on RIGHT) is missed, throw from Drop Zone (Short Tee) with penalty.

#### Hole 10

Road on LEFT and beyond is OB.

#### Hole 11

Road on LEFT and beyond is OB.

#### Hole 12

Paved road in front of MPO/MP40 Tee is OB. Paved road on LEFT and beyond is OB Racquetball, tennis courts, and related sidewalk are OB.

#### Hole 13

Road on LEFT and beyond is OB. Parking lot up the hill on LEFT is OB. Paved roads around basket and beyond are OB. Hole 14 tee pads are OB.

#### Hole 14

Tees are considered islands and are inbounds. If drive does not cross land inbounds (i.e. beyond the near road), player must re-tee with penalty. Paved road in front of Tees is OB. Paved road on LEFT and beyond is OB. Otherwise, normal OB rules apply.

#### Hole 15

Paved road on LEFT and beyond is OB. If Mando is missed, from FPO/MP40 Tee, must throw from MPO Tee with penalty.

#### Hole 16

No OB anywhere. MPO/MP40 only: Mando located on RIGHT tree. If Mando is missed, throw from Drop Zone (FPO Tee) with penalty.

#### Hole 17

Paved road on RIGHT and beyond is OB.

#### Hole 18

White painted line on LEFT and BEHIND basket is OB. Otherwise, road is OB.

## **SPECTATORS**

Each spectator will be required to follow local, county, and PDGA regulations and appropriate fan code of conduct. If unable to follow these regulations and guidelines, you will be asked to leave the park.

For this tournament at Tom Brown Park, spectators may follow behind the players within the fairways, but must follow directions of course marshals. No spectators will be allowed on Holes 5 and 6.

Please arrive at the course no earlier than 7:15am.

#### Spectator Rules of Conduct

Spectators must not interfere with any groups in play. You must heed the direction of the event staff. Any persons not following protocols will be escorted from the property.

Spectators must remain respectful to all players and other patrons. Any unruly behavior will result in being escorted from the property. This includes unsupervised or unruly children. Spectators are not allowed to approach the players during their round of competition play. Spectators shall not approach players in the parking area, warm-up area, or on the course. Autographs can be sought after competitor rounds conclude. Any persons not following this protocol will be escorted from the property.

Spectators are not allowed in the player parking area. Any persons entering this area will be escorted from the property.

No outside alcoholic beverages are allowed in the event.

No pets allowed.

#### **Spectator Camera Policy**

No flash photography. This is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate removal from the property.

No live streaming on personal devices. This is also strictly enforced and grounds for immediate removal

No cameras with detachable lenses or shutters. If your camera makes any sound at all, leave it at home.


## ARTISANAL SUDOKU

along gray lines, digits increase from the circle to the tip


