Location of Proposed Work:

The area affected by this project consists of infrastructure in the following location:
3256 Capital Circle SW, Tallahassee, Florida 32310

Proposed Work and Purpose:

The City of Tallahassee plans to enhance economic and community investment by constructing a new bulk aircraft storage hangar at the City's municipal airport, Tallahassee International Airport. The Hangar Expansion Project will enable significant expansion of the local aircraft maintenance and flight training industries, and strengthen aviation infrastructure at the Airport to enhance both economic capacity and disaster response readiness for future events. This Project will construct approximately 15,000 square feet of new hangar space for aircraft service and maintenance, along with 10,000 square feet of office space. The project also includes about 6,000 square feet of connecting aircraft apron, approximately 19,000 square feet of vehicle parking, utility connections, and stormwater improvements needed to support the new facility.

The project will comply with all regulatory requirements, including permitting and inspections, to guarantee technical feasibility and safety. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions.

Project Alternatives:

The alternatives to the project that have been and will be considered are 1) the No Action Alternative and 2) secondary off-airport or regional sites for business expansion. These alternatives to the proposed project are not viable because under Alternative 1) the Airport and local aviation businesses would not benefit from needed economic revitalization and would remain vulnerable to post-disaster losses, and Alternative 2) relocating the project forces the high-value commercial tenants to seek locations out of the region and leads to permanent loss of aviation sector jobs, private investment, business growth and significant regional economic impacts.

Comment Period:

Comments are solicited from the public; local, state or federal agencies; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of the proposed project.
